YOU WILL NEED:

Pegboards:
Large square
Small circle

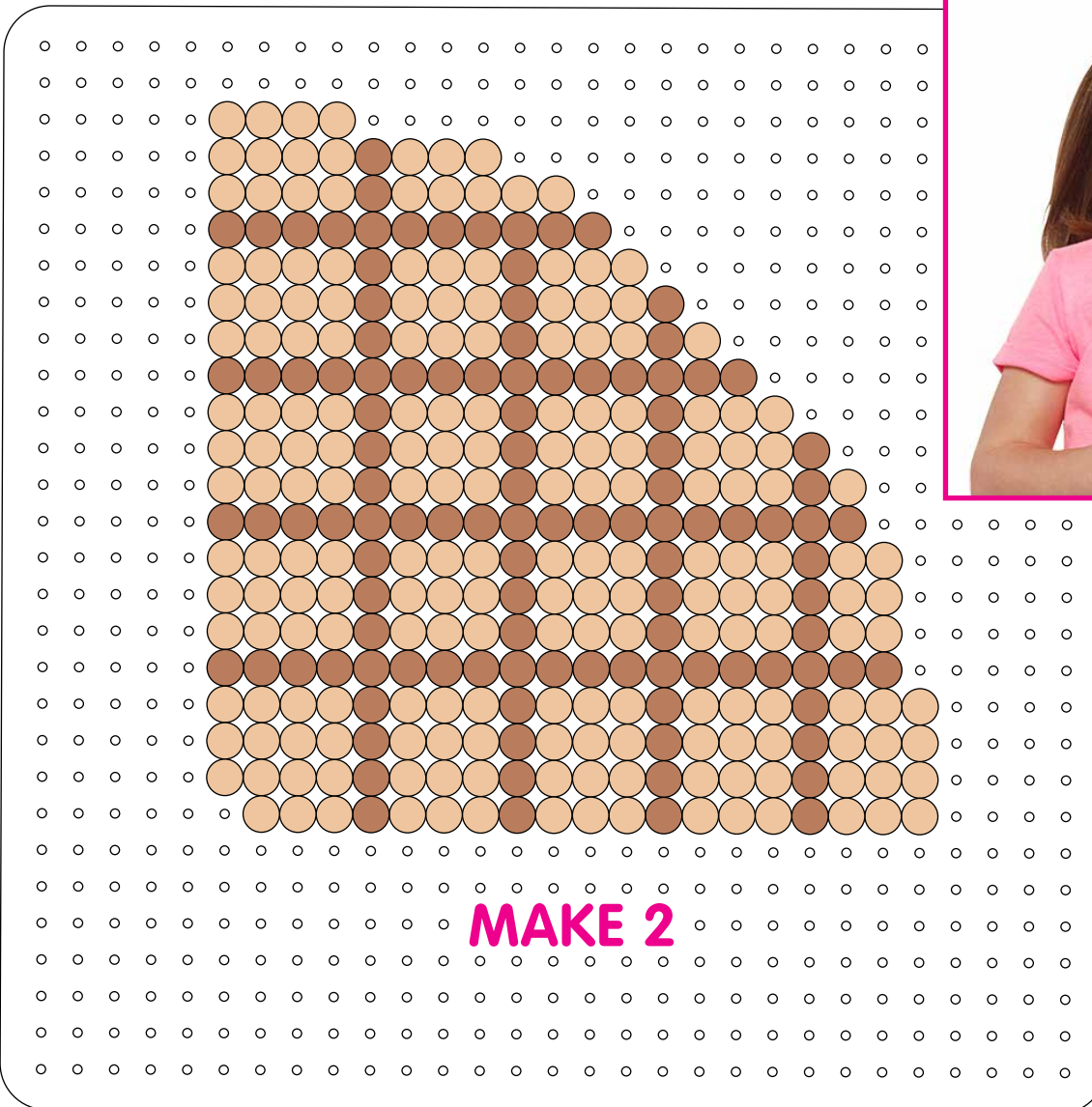
Other:
Hot glue gun

Bead Colors:

-  Light Pink - 304
-  Bubblegum - 92
-  Light Green - 117
-  Tan - 394
-  Light Brown - 224
-  White - 279

Instructions

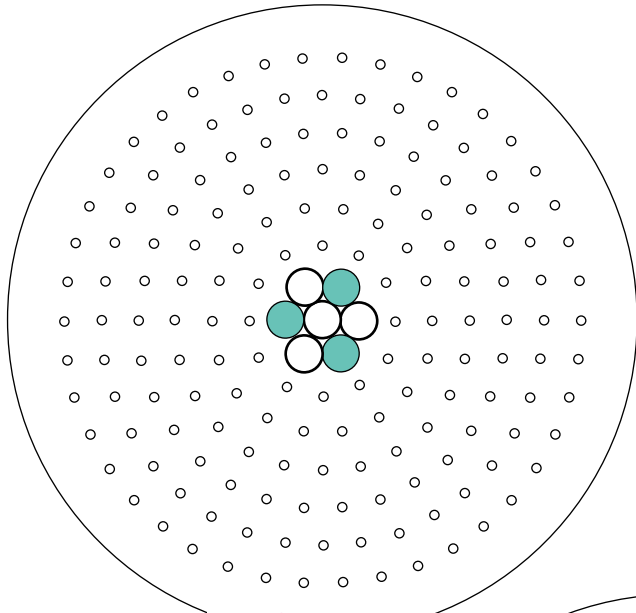
1. Place your beads on the pegboards as shown. If you are using a clear pegboard, slide the actual-size pattern underneath it.
2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 4 for further instructions.
3. Assembly: see page 4.



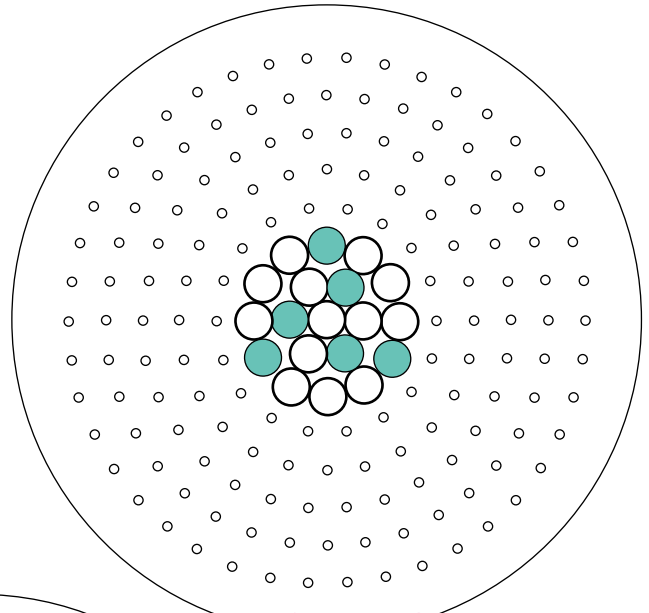

Peppermint Swirl

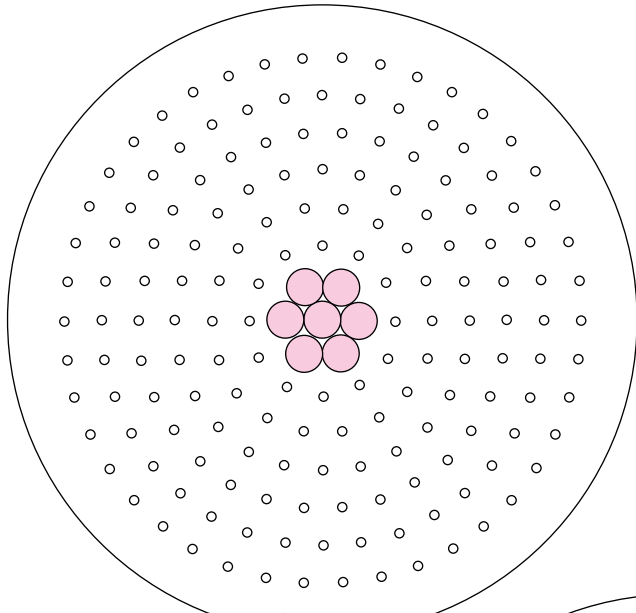

Chunky Strawberry

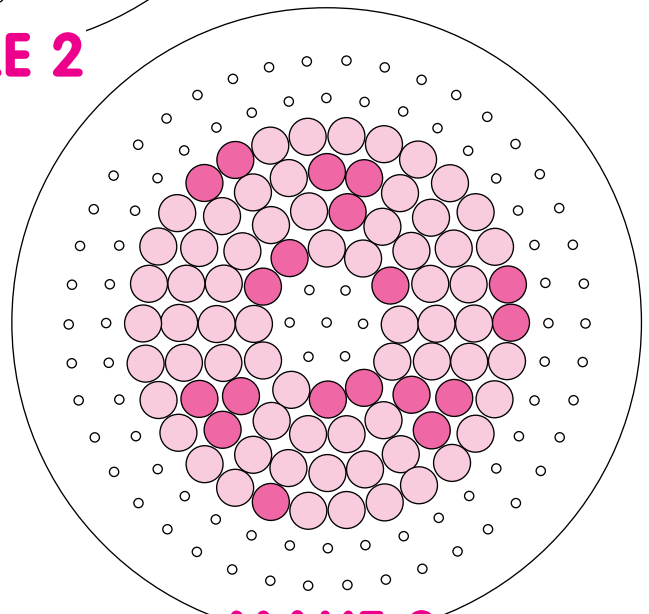

Before you fuse, please note:

- Fuse the cone part of the project on one side only. Wait a few seconds until the beads are slightly cooled to touch with your hands, then curl the piece into a cone shape. Hold it until cool. Then ask an adult to help gluing the cone edges together with a hot glue gun. Being careful not to touch the hot glue, again hold the cone firmly until the glue has cooled.
- Fuse the ice cream pieces on both sides.

Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required.

ASSEMBLY:

1. **Peppermint Swirl:** Build up your ice cream starting with the largest circles. Stack the 2 circles aligning the green beads, then rotate the top circle one bead to the left. Secure with hot glue. Repeat the same process for the other layers. Glue one white bead to the very top to finish.

2. **Chunky Strawberry:** Assemble the ice cream in a similar way as the Peppermint Swirl, but rotate the circles randomly for each size circle to create the "chunks". Glue one light pink bead to the very top to finish.

3. Glue the stacked ice creams to the top of the cones.
